These exquisite textiles from the JAB textile group have been designed in a sophisticated yet traditional style and echo the warmth of summer.

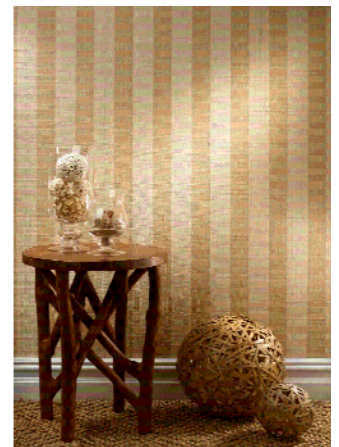

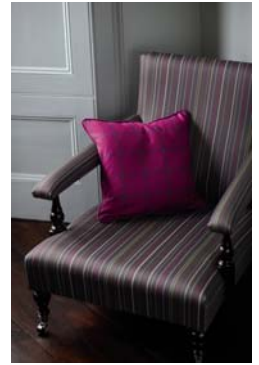
